### **1. Recognition and Appreciation**

- Publicly acknowledge achievements (e.g., shout-outs in meetings, newsletters)
- Celebrate milestones (work anniversaries, project completions)
- Implement peer-to-peer recognition programs

### **2. Growth and Development Opportunities**

- Offer training, workshops, and mentorship programs
- Support career advancement through internal promotions
- Encourage cross-training and skill-building

### **3. Empowerment and Autonomy**

- Involve employees in decision-making
- Give them ownership of projects or initiatives
- Trust them to manage their time and tasks

### **4. Positive Work Environment**
